LEADERSHIP

- 1. Monitor your FMCSA Safety Measurement System (SMS) results.
 - SMS can be used to track your roadside inspections, accidents, moving violations, and more. Monitor results regularly for accuracy and negative trends.
- 2. Request access to Great West's online portal.

For Great West insureds, go to <u>gwccnet.com</u> to request login credentials. The portal can be used to review your insurance policy information, claims, and driver list, as well as to access risk control services.

3. Share your company's Learning Library login credentials with employees.

The Learning Library is a free resource to help support your training efforts. To get started, go to <u>greatwest.infinit-i.net</u>. Here, employees can only watch videos, not view or edit policy information.

4. Develop your risk management skills.
